*****TIPS:** Have you tried on your outfit with your full makeup? Make sure your lipstick, coordinates with your outfit. Remember you will be on stage so a heavier makeup look will be acceptable. Do you have coordinating jewelry?

Sunday, April 19TH 9:00 – 2:00 pm HORSEMANSHIP PRACTICE
HORSEMANSHIP at Poway Valley Riders Association, PVRA. BRING YOUR HORSES. HORSEMANSHIP MUSIC BURNED ON A CD IS DUE. WRITE YOUR NAME ON YOUR CD WITH A SHARPEE. PLEASE BRING A CD WITH ONLY ONE SONG ON IT. YOU WILL NOT GET IT BACK. All artwork for advertisements due. Horsemanship Pageant rehearsal for grand entry and run through of contestants with music.

*****HORSE** - Start cleaning your tack and grooming your horse. The difference between a bad clipping job and a good one is two weeks. If you feel you need to clip your horse do it at least two weeks before the pageant. Otherwise clip ankles and muzzle. Wash your saddle pad, polo wraps, splint boots, etc. Make sure your horses feet are in order - once dry buff with steel wool and top with hoof polish. Wash and braid tail and mane. Blanket or use a day sheet for your horse overnight before the pageant to help keep him/her clean. Have a show-quality horse ready to go on the day of the pageant.

*****TIPS: OUTFITS** - Go to 99 cent store. Buy garment bags. Put everything you need for that outfit in your garment bag. Put earrings in zip lock baggy and safety pin to inside of garment bag. Make a checklist for each outfit. Hat, belt, belt buckle, earrings, boots, socks or stockings. Make sure your clothes are pressed and starched. Make sure your boots are cleaned and polished! Have you bought hair spray, bobby pins, doubled sided tape? Make sure it's packed and ready for horsemanship and pageant night

Thursday, April 30th – 6:00 WRITTEN TEST. Location TBA. Parents drop off contestants and return after testing. Get your thank you letters finished and in the mail. You will be excused after you finish the test. The committee will stay to correct tests.

*****APPOINTMENTS - Make hair and nail appointments next week. Get hats shaped. If pulling your hair back for horsemanship, do you have a coordinating bow or hair clip? If you do not -- get one. Make a tape recording of your speech. Study terms and practice your speech.**

*****TIPS:** Double check your check list. You should have everything packed and ready to go. Don't forget your makeup box, hair spray, fine tooth comb, mirror, curling iron, baby wipes, tissues, double sided tape, emergency sewing kit complete with safety pins and thread the same color as your dress.

Wednesday, May 6th 6:00, MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSAL - SPEECHES AND PRODUCTION at Midland MPR. **ALL MONEY DUE!!!**

Friday, May 8th, 6:30 - 7:30 Pageant Set Up -- Pageant Committee Midland Elementary School MPR.

All times, dates and locations are subject to change. Meetings start at 6:00 Sharp. Try to arrive by 5:45

Saturday, May 9th – Start Time 9:00 am at PVRA, HORSEMANSHIP COMPETITION Arrive after 6.00 a.m. Be lined up and ready to go at 8:30 for tack check. Do not be late! You need to have time to warm up your horse thoroughly before the event begins. Plan accordingly. Once the 8:45 line-up is called, parents, family members, and friends will not be allowed to visit with you until the end of your age category in Horsemanship. You may not leave until all horsemanship categories are completed.

11:00 am PERSONAL INTERVIEWS ***TIMES TO BE ASSIGNED. PVRA GROUNDS. Contestants will be sequestered during their division's interviews. As soon as your interview is completed you will be escorted to your trailer at which time you must immediately leave the grounds.

6:30 pm PAGEANT AND CORONATION at Midland MPR
Arrive at 5 PM. Pageant starts at 6:00 PM. Parents and friends may help you bring your clothes back stage but then they must leave. There will be people in the back to assist you. Please try and have as much hair and makeup done before you come so you will only need a touch up. We will be going to Kaminski's following the Pageant to celebrate all of your hard work. This is optional and you must pay for yourself.
